# July Course & Grounds Report

Why are the sprinklers running during the day? There are several reasons for watering during the day. One of which is to preserve water by not watering the same night it rains. So, if the course is dry and there is a chance of overnight rain we do not set up the irrigation to run. Waiting until morning to water allows the golf course conditions to remain firm and also reduces the turfgrass disease pressure that is associated with heavily watered grass. Most turfgrass diseases are caused by fungi. How do fungi spread and infect large areas of turf? The answer is: through water. So reducing water usage also reduces the possibility and severity of diseases.

Humidity levels play a big factor in daily watering. We may know it is going to be 90 degrees the next day, which most people would think to water the night before, however, if the humidity level is high then the evaporation rate is low and moisture stavs in the turf and there is no need to irrigate. On the other hand, if the humidity is low and the temperature is 90 degrees in combination with a little wind you may see turf wilt very quickly.

Syringing is a light application of water sprayed on the greens, tees and fairways during the heat of the day to reduce the turf canopy temperature by a couple of degrees. This is done because the turf at Seven Oaks is comprised mostly of creeping bentgrass and annual bluegrass which is properly pronounced Poa annua not Po anna. Creeping bentgrass has a drought mechanism which allows it to survive under the stressful summer heat. Poa annua or annual bluegrass does not have this mechanism, so by syringing the turf during the heat of the day we can lower the temperature at the turf canopy by a couple degrees which is often enough to allow the survival of the annual bluegrass.

Well it rained last night how come you are watering today? During periods of high temperatures the grass plant can not move enough water from the roots and out through the leaves to stay cool. A light syringing of water will help the plant out in these situations.

We will try to make your round as pleasant as possible by only watering during the day when it is absolutely critical to the health of the turf.

Members are asked to assist in maintaining required service levels by making reservations for dining prior to 3 PM on the day involved. A 24 hour notice is requested for parties of more than six (6) persons. We request that members who have special dietary needs notify the Club ahead of time. Reservations for dining will be held for only fifteen (15) minutes after the reserved time.

Club Special Events. Reservations are required for activities of the Club and shall be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis by pre-registering with the Club office. For all functions of the Club held in the dining rooms of the Club, tables will be assigned on a first-call, first-choice basis. Reservations for special tables will not be accepted. We cannot guarantee that groups larger than ten will be seated at the same table. Cancellation of a reservation must occur 48 hours prior to the social function. Pool events do not require a reservation. The courtesy of providing notice of reservation changes is requested 24 hours before the event is scheduled.

Banquets. Reservations for banquets should be made at least two (2) weeks in advance. Notification of cancellations for a banquet event must be made four weeks before the event is scheduled. The final guest count is required one week before the function. After the final count is given the guest count may not be lowered, however additions may be made up to 3% of the total count. A fee of 10% of the total food cost will be charged for any guest count being added above 3% after the final guest count has been determined. A non-refundable deposit is required for banquet reservations. Failure to cancel dining and special event reservations will result in a charge to the member's Club account.
