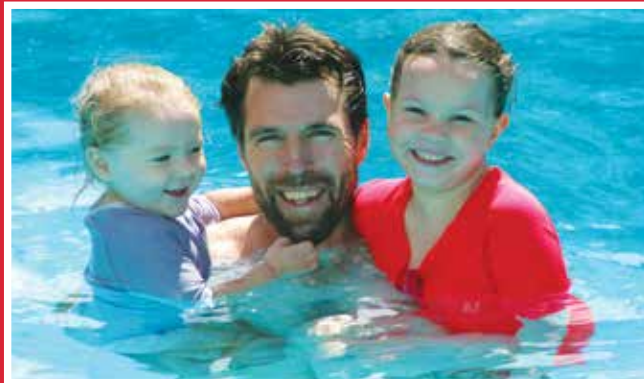

## June Course & Grounds Report

### How's Your Course Etiquette?

"My course etiquette is great because I always fix my ball mark and usually a couple more!" exclaims the golfer as he drives up next to the edge of the green while his cigar wrapper flies out of the cart. Picture that scenario and think about all the other aspects of golf course etiquette that golfers must follow.

The USGA rulebook addresses etiquette in the very first section and stresses that maximum enjoyment is obtained when players are considerate and take care of the golf course. While the rulebook lists some of the following guidelines I will add a couple not listed.

Take the following test. Do you do any of the following?

1. Go off the path when it is cart path only.
2. Drive up right next to greens and tees.
3. Make sharp fast turns on fairways.
4. Spit sunflower seeds on greens.
5. Drag your feet on greens.
6. Create a depression by leaning on or dropping the flagstick.
7. Jam the flagstick into the edge of the hole.
8. Kneel on the green to check your line.
9. Not fix your ball mark properly.
10. Allow cigar ashes to drop onto the green.
11. Move the tee markers to rest your cigar.
12. Allow your cigar wrapper to blow out of the cart.
13. Twist your feet on the green.
14. Scoop the ball out of the cup with your putter.
15. Spray insect repellent while standing on grass, which then kills the grass.
16. Throw cigarette butts into bunkers.
17. Not rake bunkers in the evening assuming they will be raked the following day.
18. Drive past cart directional signs.
19. Not level your sand filled fairway or tee divot with your foot.
20. Kick the sand off your shoes when on the green.
21. Spit chewing tobacco on the green.
22. Practice hitting chip shots onto the greens and not fix ball marks.

Don't do any of the above? Congratulations you are protecting the integrity of the game and hopefully others will follow by your actions!

## Reservations and Cancellation Policies

**Grille Room Dining.** No member or committee shall plan or set dates for dining room activities without prior approval of Seven Oaks Country Club. Dining reservations are highly recommended. Members are asked to assist in maintaining required service levels by making reservations for dining prior to 3 PM on the day involved. A 24 hour notice is requested for parties of more than six (6) persons. We request that members who have special dietary needs notify the Club ahead of time. Reservations for dining will be held for only fifteen (15) minutes after the reserved time.

**Club Special Events.** Reservations are required for activities of the Club and shall be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis by pre-registering with the Club office. For all functions of the Club held in the dining rooms of the Club, tables will be assigned on a first-call, first-choice basis. Reservations for special tables will not be accepted. We cannot guarantee that groups larger than ten will be seated at the same table. Cancellation of a reservation must occur 48 hours prior to the social function. Pool events do not require a reservation. The courtesy of providing notice of reservation changes is requested 24 hours before the event is scheduled.

**Banquets.** Reservations for banquets should be made at least two (2) weeks in advance. Notification of cancellations for a banquet event must be made four weeks before the event is scheduled.

The final guest count is required one week before the function. After the final count is given the guest count may not be lowered, however additions may be made up to 3% of the total count. A fee of 10% of the total food cost will be charged for any guest count being added above 3% after the final guest count has been determined. A non-refundable deposit is required for banquet reservations. Failure to cancel dining and special event reservations will result in a charge to the member's Club account. The dining, special event and banquet policies shall be determined by Seven Oaks Country Club.


