The "Story" Behind Our New Logo

You may have noticed recently that our e-mails have a different look with our NEW Seven Oaks logo. Looks pretty regal we think. We hope you like it too! And there's more to the logo than just the look. We wanted more than just something pretty or spiffy looking. We wanted a logo that reflected who we are and what we represent. Here's the story behind the design.

The "7" represents where we began, specifically the seven oak trees on the property when it was purchased by the Greek Catholic Union in 1968. Since that time we've seen the emergence of hundreds of more oak trees on our beautiful property. The oak tree is cherished nationwide for its beauty, abundant shade, and enduring strength. In fact, in 2004 the oak tree was designated as the official "National Tree" of the United States of America. The "Oak Leaves" represent the humble beginnings of an oak tree from a tiny, single acorn. Through patience and endurance the tree emerges and over time becomes a magnificent entity whose many branches continue to strengthen and reach skyward with each passing year, just as we strive to do at your club.

Finally, our new logo is designed as a "Family Crest", a representation of our family values at Seven Oaks and the GCU. We consider our club members and our local community an extended family and enjoy being a conduit to bring everyone together. We hope that on a personal basis you visit your club often and make many special, lasting family memories.

April Course & Grounds Report

Where is your cart? Is your cart parked to the right of 1 green or to the right of 9 tee?

Does your cart drive right past cart directional signs?

Last fall and this spring email communications regarding our effort to seed around greens and tees that were damaged by fungal diseases from heat and humidity in 2016 were sent out on multiple occasions requesting that carts stay on paths near greens and tees. Observations from last fall and early play this year show that the message is not getting through.

Help from carts is also needed near cart directional signs that are used around wet or high traffic areas. These signs keep carts off wet and high traffic areas and allow the carts to go off the path on drier holes instead of making the entire course cart path only.

Please help us keep the carts on paths when putting or tee-ing off, and obeying cart directional signs. If your cart is having trouble following the above mentioned requests then please return it to the Golf Shop for a different one.

Aeration. Greens aeration is scheduled for April 24th and 25th. Completion in the spring is necessary to prepare the turf for the summer stresses, which include: heat, rainfall, disease, insects and compaction. Autumn is the next best time to aerate because root growth is maximized and soil compaction is reduced from the summer season.

Below is a list of benefits that occur from aeration:

- ☀ Decreased compaction.
- ☀ Increased root development.
- ☀ Increased drainage.
- ☀ Decreased thatch development.
- ☀ Increased tolerance to heat.
- ☀ Increased water and nutrient uptake to the plant.
- ☀ Reduced isolated dry spots.
- ☀ Increased tolerance to insects and disease.

Slow Play-It isn't my fault!

Golf Digest recently did a survey (see results below) where they asked golfers to rate their own pace of play versus other golfers. Their conclusion.....it's not my fault, it's the other golfers!

Q: How would you rate your own pace of play?

Fast: 57.8 percent

Average: 37.4 percent

Slow: 4.8 percent

Q: How would you rate most golfers' pace of play?

Slow: 56.2 percent

Average: 41.8 percent

Fast: 2.0 percent

We understand that you may have guests that are important to your business or friends whose feelings you don't want to hurt, however you are actually doing them a favor by encouraging them to move along. 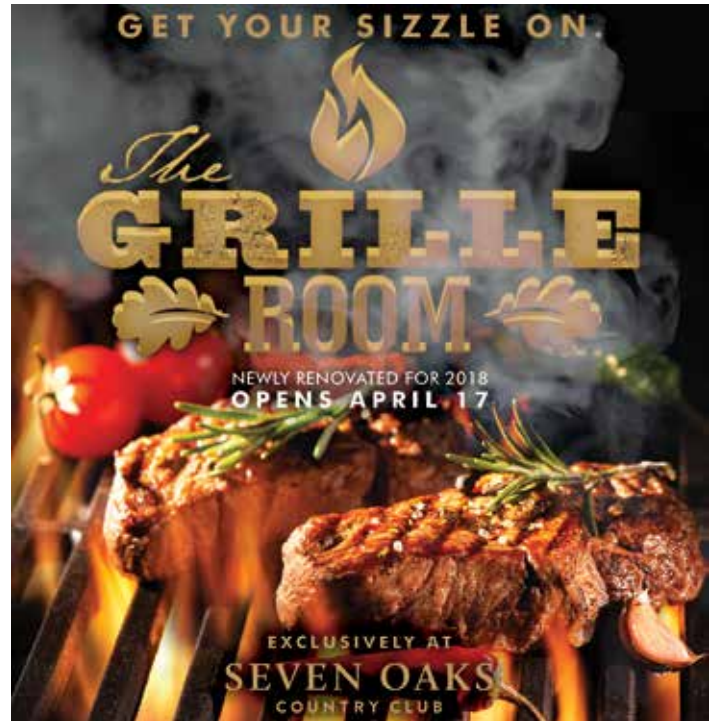

Reservations and Cancellation Policies

Grille Room Dining. No member or committee shall plan or set dates for dining room activities without prior approval of Seven Oaks Country Club. Dining reservations are highly recommended. Members are asked to assist in maintaining required service levels by making reservations for dining prior to 3 PM on the day involved. A 24 hour notice is requested for parties of more than six (6) persons. We request that members who have special dietary needs notify the Club ahead of time. Reservations for dining will be held for only fifteen (15) minutes after the reserved time.

Club Special Events. Reservations are required for activities of the Club and shall be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis by pre-registering with the Club office. For all functions of the Club held in the dining rooms of the Club, tables will be assigned on a first-call, first-choice basis. Reservations for special tables will not be accepted. We cannot guarantee that groups larger than ten will be seated at the same table. Cancellation of a reservation must

occur 48 hours prior to the social function. Pool events do not require a reservation. The courtesy of providing notice of reservation changes is requested 24 hours before the event is scheduled.

Banquets. Reservations for banquets should be made at least two (2) weeks in advance. Notification of cancellations for a banquet event must be made four weeks before the event is scheduled. The final guest count is required one week before the function. After the final count is given the guest count may not be lowered, however additions may be made up to 3% of the total count. A fee of 10% of the total food cost will be charged for any guest count being added above 3% after the final guest count has been determined. A non-refundable deposit is required for banquet reservations. Failure to cancel dining and special event reservations will result in a charge to the member's club account. The dining, special event and banquet policies shall be determined by Seven Oaks Country Club.
