### Items to note in the 2023 Seven Oaks Tournament Season

- There is an 18-year-old age minimum for all Seven Oaks Golf Committee events, with the exception of the Club Championship IF that player's index qualifies him for the Championship Flight (6.0 index or lower at the time of the event)
- Member-Guest Entry Fee will be increased to \$860 per team but will now include all cart fees for member and guest, including practice round.
- Recreational members of Seven Oaks Country Club are allowed to play as the "guest" *only* in the Men's Invitational and the Ringer Open.
- For Men's Golf Committee events, any players will qualify for the *option* to play from the Red Tee markers if their age and handicap index combined are equal or greater than 75. They qualify for the Green Tees if their age and handicap index combined are equal or greater than 85.
- Handicap indexes and flights will be pulled from the day prior to the tournament starting. If there are scheduled practice rounds involved, indexes will be pulled the day prior to the practice round.

### Items to note for Posting Scores and Handicap Indexes

- Post the day you play! Handicap indexes update for each person every single night, so you will need to post the same day you play a round to insure the most accurate handicap each day.
- Post your score hole-by-hole. Not only does it help Seven Oaks CC and our Men's Golf Committee with stroke allocation and tournament details, but it will also do the math for you in case you have to take a max score on any given hole.
- The posting schedule for this area is April 1 – November 14 each year. November 15 – March 31 is considered an off season. You may still post "Away" scores if you travel in the winter to an area that posts year-round.
- The Men's Golf Committee Handicap oversight committee has the power to post actual scores and penalty scores for individuals at the club.
- The Men's Golf Committee Handicap oversight committee also has the power to change/update/modify any handicap index for any period, including tournaments.

# The Seven Oaks Top 10

Over the course of the season players will earn points for each Men's Golf Committee event they play in. Points will be awarded based on participation, the event played and what place they finish. At the end of the season, the Top 10 players who have accumulated the most points will be awarded prizes based on their finish. It is also important to know that players may also earn points by participating in the weekly SWATS game. Below you will find a scale on how points are awarded.

# SWATS

- The SWATS game is a weekly game conducted every Saturday & Sunday based on availability. SWAT games are also conducted on certain Holiday Monday's designated by the Golf Shop.
- Players will earn season long points towards The Seven Oaks Top 10 list for participation from 4/15/23 thru 9/3/23. You can obtain a maximum of 2 points per month playing SWATS.
- All players must call or notify the Golf Shop by 8:00 a.m. to sign up.
- All play will begin with the first tee times starting on Hole #1. No shotguns or Back 9 starts will take place unless the Golf Shop approves. You must tee off before 10:30 AM to be a SWAT participant.
- All games will be based off 100% of the player's course handicap.
- Summer rules will be in effect unless the Golf Shop alters based on course conditions (i.e. winter rules or lift, clean and place).
- The Golf Shop to determine game.
- Both the Saturday & Sunday game entry fee is \$21 dollars (\$5 dollars to skin game, \$15 dollars to Team or Individual game and \$1 dollar to staff).
- Members whose age and handicap index equal or greater than 75 shall be permitted to play from the Red Tees. Members whose age and handicap index equal or greater than 85 shall be permitted to play from the Green Tees. Course/Tee Rating & Slope will be followed per USGA for all play.

- DATE:** April 29<sup>th</sup> – August 31<sup>st</sup>
- FEE:** \$55.00 per person
- PRIZES:** Trophy to the Overall Winner and golf shop credit to the winners
- FORMAT:** Individual Match Play
- TEES:** Orange or (Red tee = age + handicap index equal or greater than 75, Green tee = age + handicap index equal or greater than 85)
- HANDICAP:** 100% of player's course handicap. Scorecards will be dotted off of the low player's handicap. The difference between the player's handicaps will give the higher handicapped player the number of strokes he receives for the match
- SPECIAL RULES:** Players will be responsible for scheduling each match with their opponent – not the golf shop. If the match is not completed by the deadline date, a coin will be flipped by the golf committee to determine a winner
- PRIZE POT:** An optional \$20 cash side pot will be available to all players. Those players advancing to the final three rounds will divide the pot according to their finish in the event.

You and your guest are cordially invited to join us June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, and 24<sup>th</sup> for the Men's Invitational. We will follow the same format as we have done in the past, a 2-Man Best Ball Match Play in Round Robin format. The event will start with a scheduled, shotgun start practice round on Thursday. The main event will be Friday and Saturday and consist of five 9-hole matches against your flight of 6 teams. We will play three 9-hole matches on Friday and the remaining two 9-hole matches on Saturday, followed by the Championship Shootout.

We will also enjoy a great night at the new Pool facility on Friday evening. The event will be officially over after the Championship Shootout and the presentation of the trophies to the flight winners and Overall Champions.

The sign-up process will be the same as last year. The teams that played last year will be grandfathered into the tournament until a certain date. They will have to confirm their guest, information, and payment to the Golf Shop. Once that date is up, those on the waiting list will fill any available openings in the order in which they were received. All active members and their guest must have an established USGA index, which is verifiable and must be at least 21 years of age. We recommend signing up for the waiting list as soon as Jason releases the registration.

A Men's Invitational packet with all the details for the event will be provided once you have signed up and we fill out our flights. Thank you for your consideration and we look forward to seeing you soon at Seven Oaks!

Chip-offs will determine advancement if teams are tied, however if the final two teams are tied a sudden death playoff will continue to hole #9 and alternate between holes #9 & #18 until a winner is determined.

HANDICAP:	90% handicap - low player in match goes to 0 and the remaining adjust accordingly
SPECIAL RULES:	Your Round 1 match must be completed on Saturday, June 3 <sup>rd</sup> . You must be in attendance in order to participate in the bracket. After Round 1 is over on June 3 <sup>rd</sup> , you will have 2-3 weeks to complete each remaining round.

TEES:	Orange or (Red tee = age + handicap index equal or greater than 75, Green tee = age + handicap index equal or greater than 85)
HANDICAP:	The partner with the lower course handicap gets 60 percent of their handicap and the partner with the higher course handicap receives 40 percent of their handicap – combine the two for the team handicap.

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## Pace of Play Policy

In 1993, the United States Golf Association developed a formula, the USGA Pace Rating, that can help players to complete a round of golf at an optimum pace. The USGA Pace Rating calculates completion time ("Time Par") for each hole on *your course*, taking into account length and difficulty of the hole and other attributes of play. Time pars allow players to keep track of when they are expected to arrive at each tee. **Seven Oaks Country Club has a pace rating of 4 hours 20 minutes. This is how long it should take to play 18 holes when our course is playing at capacity.** Seven Oaks Country Club and the Men's Golf Committee have agreed that this form of tracking "Time Par" is the most equitable and that **Members along with their guests are responsible for honoring this pace whenever they are using the golf course.** There will be times that a group may fall behind due to a lost ball or other "uncontrollable" situation. Our Staff will make every effort to assist you in regaining your position on the course. This may include raking bunkers, forecaddieing, searching for a lost ball, etc. If the group is still not making progress toward closing the gap, they will be asked to pick up and move to the next tee. **Please remember that your position on the golf course is immediately behind the group in front of you.** The position of the group behind you is not your concern. They are not part of the Time Par equation. The Golf Professional and Staff shall interpret all rules governing slow play and shall be the final authority in the enforcement of these rules.
