Cost: Ages 5-6- \$175 for 1 Child, \$150 for 2 or more children in the same family.

Ages 7-16- \$250 for 1 child, \$225 for 2 or more children from the same family.

This includes all instruction, gifts, prizes, chips & Powerade on lesson days and a lunch option on play days(for 7-16 classes).

Gifts & Prizes

Each year we give out a tee gift to all our participants. When we do competitions, the coaches may give out candy, golf balls, or other small items. We try to make sure to avoid any allergies, but if your child cannot have a particular kind of candy, please note it in the allergy section of the signup form.

Our Instructional Program:

We follow a program based on Operation 36. Juniors will all begin the first play day from 25 yards out with a goal score based on their age. When they accomplish this goal, they will get to move back further distances each time after they reach their target score. Group lesson days will cover all aspects of the game including: Putting, Chipping, Pitching, Bunkers, Irons, Woods, and the rules of golf. It is our goal to create a fun atmosphere for learning new skills and opportunities to be competitive on an individual and team level.

Other Information:

When your child(ren) is at Junior Golf, we ask that they are dressed according to the club's policies. This means they should wear a collared shirt, golf shorts or skirts (not athletic shorts) and either golf or tennis shoes. If they choose to wear a hat it must be worn with the bill forward and boys should have their shirts tucked into their shorts. We suggest that they bring a water bottle that they can carry in their bags for days we are on the golf course as we are not always close to a drinking fountain. We ask that all children attending Junior Golf have their own set of clubs. Unfortunately, the golf shop does not have enough extras to supply clubs for all the kids. We also ask that you have your child's bag clearly marked so that they know which one is theirs. This helps avoid any mishaps with clubs being put in the wrong bag or the wrong golf bag being taken home by mistake. You can also put colored tape or name tags on the individual golf clubs to identify them.

On Play Days, parents are welcome to follow groups and assist the coaches in ensuring that players make it around the golf course. We would appreciate any parents that would be interested in volunteering to stay on a weekly basis for Play Days.

In the event of weather that is severe enough for us to cancel Junior Golf for the day we will send out an email to all the emails provided on the sign-up form. Please include all the emails that need contacted for your child(ren) on their sign-up forms. We have the first week of August reserved as a "rain date" in case we must cancel 1 or more days of Junior Golf.
